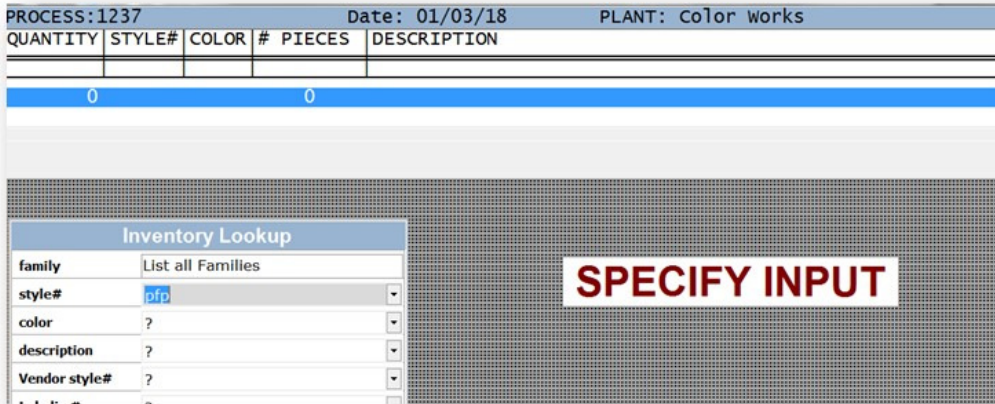
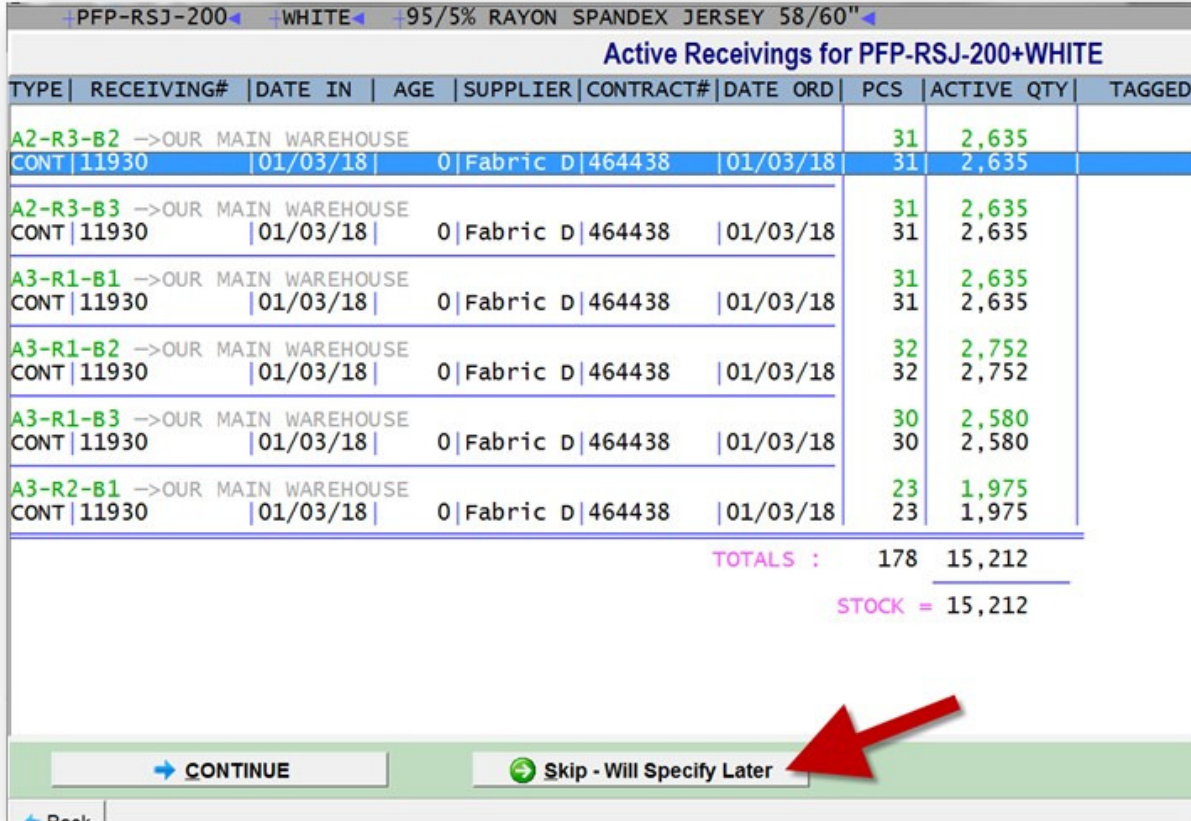


You can now use the **960 barcode device** to pack out the **Fabric Input** for all **Fabric Process Transactions**.

For a Process transaction to be eligible for 960 packing, you need to skip the roll/piece input when creating the process on your Mod2 desktop.



Click on the **SKIP – WILL SPECIFY LATER** button on the Input screen.



When you print the form of your process (i.e. Knit Dye Order), there's a barcode on the form for your warehouse to scan.

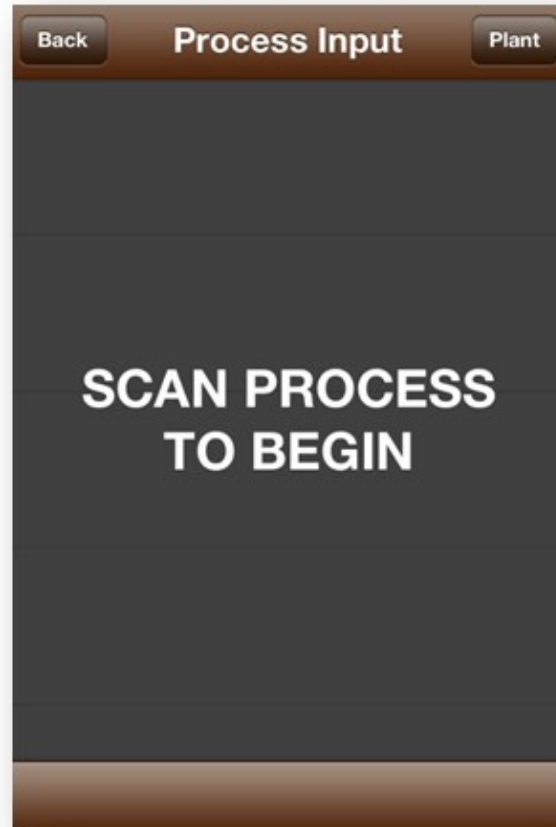
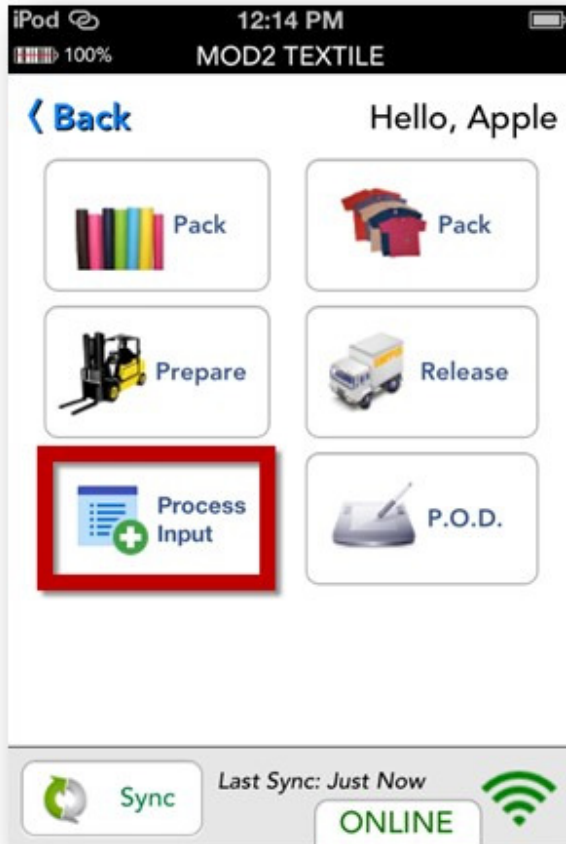


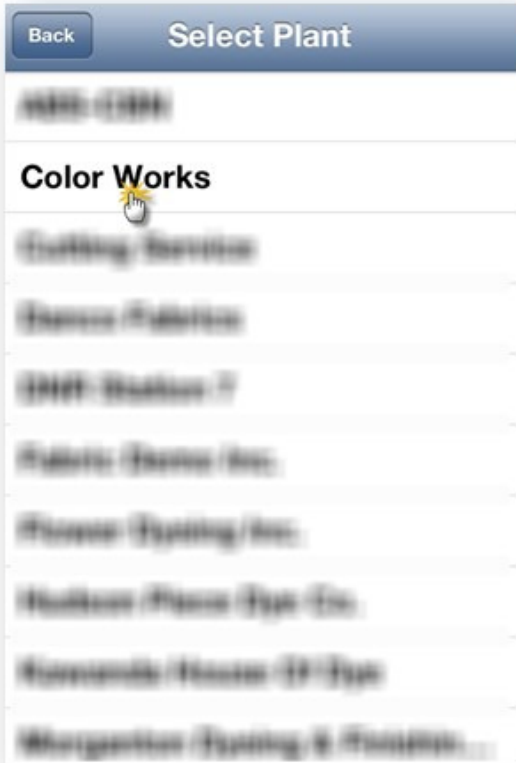

To start packing the rolls for the process, on your 960 barcode device, tap on SHIPPING then tap on PROCESS INPUT. You can scan the barcode on the form or tap on the PLANT button to list all plants and there you will find all the eligible processes.





You can also tap on the OUTPUT button to check the expected fabric output info.
